



## BIOMASS POWER PLANT, VISOKO

<b>Project title</b>	Construction of biomass power plant in Visoko	
<b>Sector</b>	Energy sector	
<b>Location</b>	Visoko Municipality	
<b>Location description</b>	Municipality Visoko is located in Central Bosnia, and administratively belongs to the Zenica-Doboj canton. Centre of the medieval Bosnian state today is a modern city with a tendency of economic development based on the favourable geographical position and its own natural and economic resources.	
<b>Company description</b>	„Dokso“ d.o.o. Visoko was formed in 1985 in a place called Donje Mostre and it is engaged in oil trade, provision of transport services, and breeding broilers . The company has three modern farms of broilers with capacity of 100 000 chickens.	
<b>Project status</b>	Business idea	
<b>Project description</b>	The goal of the company “Dokso” d.o.o. Visoko is construction of biomass power plant with capacity of 150 kW which would use chicken compost, chicken fertilizer, and manure from fattened chickens and organic waste. Also this biomass power plant will produce thermal energy which will be used to heat greenhouses for the production of fruit, vegetables, flowers etc. Biomass power plant of 150 kW would use approximately 6 000 tons of chicken compost, chicken fertilizer. Annually, “Dokso” can produce approximately 3 000 tons of chicken compost, chicken fertilizer while it would procure other 3000 tons of chicken compost from its partners, and subcontractors.
