Project title	Health- educational, recreational sports and tourism centres Koricani, Vlasic	
Sector	Tourism sector	
Location	Central Bosnia, Municipality of Knezevo and Municipality of Travnik	
Location description	This is a multi-entity project located in the Koricani village whose administration consists of the municipality of Knezevo, an entity of Republika Srpska, and also the Municipality of Travnik, an entity of the Federation of B&H. The location is designated as protected Eco Zone. All necessary infrastructure, paved roads, electric net, and water supply are provided.	
Project status	Eco Zone has obtained all the necessary approvals from the competent Governmental authority regarding the construction of the Eco Centre.	
Project description	The project involves construction of Aqua Centre, Educational centre, Residential complex, Hotel , Hostel, Restaurant and bars, Home for elderly people, Multiplex apartments, School, Kindergarten, Residential skyscraper, Hydroelectric power plant, Gas station, Offices, Shopping mall, Clinic, Cultural centre, Recreational park at the lake, and Golf park. In addition to tourism and recreational activities Eco Park also includes: two stadiums (indoor and outdoor), gym, tracks, Olympic swimming pool, and other facilities necessary for the preparation of sports teams. The complex will cover app. 20 km ² . There will be made an artificial lake on some 10-20 ha. Surplus water from the lake would supply a small HPP in the Ugar Valley and thus provide an electric-energy self-supply from the renewable sources for Centre needs. Thermal needs will be solved with a combination of solar panels and biomass, which will be provided by the local wood sector. This project is characterized as being of strategic importance.
