



FOREST PARK „HUM“ NOVO SARAJEVO

Project title	Forest Park „Hum“

Location	Municipality of Novo Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina
Location description	Forest Park “Hum” is located northwest of the Center of Sarajevo, above the settlement of Pofalici, Novo Sarajevo Municipality. Hum is recognizable by its television tower (Relay), located at the very top of the hill, at an altitude of 816 meters and 6.5 km away from the City Center. The relay, whose symbol is also on the coat of arms of the Municipality of Novo Sarajevo, is also one of the symbols of the City of Sarajevo. The largest flag of the state of Bosnia and Herzegovina has been displayed here and serves for ceremonial observation of national holidays.
Company description/ Project background	<p>Municipality of Novo Sarajevo is a local self-government unit that covers an area of 9.9 km². It is located in the central part of Sarajevo, and it is most densely populated Municipality in BiH, with the population density of over 6,470 inhabitants/km². The Municipality is committed to continuous improvement of life quality for its inhabitants, but also to attraction of a larger number of visitors. As one of the measures toward that goal, in its Development Strategy, construction of two sports and recreation zones has been planned. One of those zones is Forest Park “Hum”.</p> <p>This Forest Park should represent a unique green area near the city, where citizens of Sarajevo, as well as visitors of the city, may enjoy natural and cultural beauties of this area. Hum has very rich natural beauties – unique flora, fauna, and other features. Also, it is located in the area isolated from traffic and noise, which makes this location perfect for recreation, sports and other similar activities. As such, this Forest Park could represent “the lungs of the city”.</p>



	<p>It is important to note that in 2009, this area was defined as “forest park”, in compliance with the adopted Regulation Plan - Forest Park “Hum” (“Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton” no. 23/09).</p> <p>Until now, the preliminary architectural and development plan has been prepared for this project, as well as landscape design together with the Feasibility Study.</p>

Project description	<p>Preliminary Design has foreseen for the Forest Park to contain all elements of the public city park, with all necessary ancillary structures and utility infrastructure. The entire park is planned with sports and recreation, service and education facilities, where citizens of all age groups will be able to rest, recreate and educate (children, young people, elderly, persons playing sports and other recreational activities), which should contribute to increase of the quality of life. The following zones have been planned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Viewpoint zone with service facilities, which will provide a beautiful view of the city and wider area, - Sports and recreation zone, - Recreation facilities (in both zones), - Cable car that would connect the Forest Park “Hum” with the other sports and recreation zone located at the foot of the Hum Hill. <p>Implementation of the project requires cooperation of the Municipality of Novo Sarajevo and the Government of the Canton of Sarajevo, the City of Sarajevo, the Ministry of Physical Planning, Construction and Environmental Protection of the Canton of Sarajevo and other relevant institutions.</p>
