FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PROCESSING PLANT, LJUBINJE

Project title	Construction of fruit and vegetable processing plant
Sector	Agriculture Industry
Location	Municipality of Ljubinje
Location description	Municipality of Ljubinje is situated in south-eastern part of Herzegovina region with proximity to the borders with Croatia and Montenegro. The location planned for factory construction occupies an area of 20,000 m ² with complete utility infrastructure and near to the cooling plants Fruveko and Bovel.
Project description	The project proposes construction of the Plant for fruit and vegetable processing. It is currently business idea with ongoing preparation of town planning documentation. Expected fruit yield in the territory of the Ljubinje municipality and neighbouring municipalities of St. Ilija, Ravnice, Ljubinje, Bilje, and Brekovići in 2011 by culture were: sour cherries (2,980,000kg), apples (3,320,000kg), plums (130,000 kg), cherries (190,000 kg), peaches (3,325,000 kg), nectarines (1,425,000 kg), grape vine – grapes (1,525,000 kg), strawberries (120,000 kg), domestic pomegranate (500,000 kg) and wild pomegranate (6,900,000 kg), and vegetables: peppers (700,000 kg), potatoes (550,000 kg) - which presents a great opportunity for fruit and vegetable plant construction.
Estimated total investment cost	300,000 KM (app. 153,388 EUR)
