GREENHOUSE PRODUCTION, SANSKI MOST

Project title	Increasing capacities for agricultural greenhouse production
Sector	Agriculture industry
Location description	Sanski Most is located in north-western part of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in the middle of the Sana river drainage area, and occupies an area of 781 km with app. 51,000 inhabitants. According to the structure of agricultural land use, 61% are arable land and gardens (23 958 ha). The rest of the arable land is covered with orchards (653 hectares or 2%) and natural meadows (7068 ha or 18% of total agricultural area). The remaining land is pasture (6071 ha) and natural ponds (1551 ha).
Project status	Feasibility study completed by the Agricultural Faculty in Sarajevo (May 2011)
Project description	<p>The current level of greenhouse production in the area of Sanski is insufficient to meet domestic needs, with the low level of necessary technological equipment. This project foresees the establishment of 100 new private farms at the total land area of 95,000m². The farms will be of different size as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 50 farms with the land surface of 500m² - 30 farms with the land surface of 1.000m² - 20 farms with the land surface of 2.000m² <p>The spring planting will include production of greenhouse tomatoes, peppers and cucumber in a ratio of 40:40:20, while autumn sowing planned spinach, lettuce and onions in a ratio of 70:20:10.</p>
