<b>Project title</b>	Production and processing of tomatoes and new plant for ketchup production
<b>Sector</b>	Agriculture sector
<b>Location</b>	Prnjavor Municipality
<b>Location description</b>	Mladegs Pak company is located in Prnjavor Municipality, along the Banja Luka-Doboj highway. Municipality of Prnjavor is situated in the Northwest part of BiH, at the distance of around 50 km from the border with the Croatia/European Union.
<b>Company description</b>	Mladegs Pak is a producer of delicious quality food products from Bosnia and Herzegovina, with a tradition that lasts since 1989. Currently, the company employs over 200 workers and products can be found in the following countries: Switzerland, Australia, Macedonia, Slovenia, Austria, Croatia, Romania, Czech Republic, Slovakia, and Hungary. Product assortment contains 220 various items, and two domestic brands, Bonito and Dominus. The company owns HACCP, IFS Food version 6, and ISO 9001:2008 certificates.
<b>Project status</b>	In progress
<b>Project description</b>	The project proposes: <b>1. Investment in new plant for the ketchup production</b> Construction of a production building for the ketchup production is ongoing, with a capacity of 100 tons per day for the EU market. Mladegs Pak is seeking a partner and has a secured market in the European Union. <b>2. Investment in primary production and processing of tomatoes</b> The plan is investing in planting tomatoes on about 100 hectares and construction a processing plant for tomato. It is necessary to provide the land for planting.
<b>Estimated total investment cost</b>	Estimated total investment costs are 7 million EUR: - New plant for the ketchup production 3.5 million EUR - Primary production and processing of tomatoes 3.5 million EUR The owner has already invested 40%
