Project title	The construction of sports and recreation centre Sokolac

Location	Sokolac Municipality	
Location description	The planned location is on the slopes between the parking space of the universal sports hall and football stadium of the club "Glasinac" in Sokolac. The main road Sarajevo-Belgrade is in the immediate vicinity Sarajevo City, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and well as Jahorina Olympic Center are 40 km away.	
Project status	The main project is finished (architectural project)	
Project description	This project proposes the construction of sports and recreation centre in Sokolac Municipality. Within the open pool, the construction of three outdoor swimming pools is planned; one is for swimmers (25m x13,5m, depth of 1.35m to 1.85m) one for swimming courses (10m x 13.5m, depth 1.10m) and one for children (diameter 10m, depth 0.3m). The capacity is 205 users at the same time, and 420 users at the open, for a total of 615 users. The construction of the pool is followed by the construction of the necessary facilities, dressing room with changing rooms, restrooms and showers. The planned facility would be a floor (in one part) and a floor +1 (second part) with the total area of 1156.30 m ² (lower ground floor 925.50 m ² and higher ground floor 230,80 m ²). Right next to the planned center there is a stadium that is already built, and there are also two playgrounds: a small playground- hard surface (concrete) and additional football turf field, the existing universal gym with its parking, as well as the associated boiler, which will be serving during winter for the needs of the projected pool complex.
